Nov 19 Drew a load of wood from the end of the Barn, the
snow 8 inches
deep old calf pen & worked at the stable & snowed most of the
last night

20 Rob Beatty came up from young in the Buggy the Road,
is very bad drew 2 of sand to the stable & 1 to the
house for bank it I have not got it banked yet

21 Walter & David got home from Red River this morning
they went to Delta this afternoon on the Express Adam
went to Nebraska from St Palls to see Isabella

22 worked at the stable lowered the top log 4 inches it
snow was to high stormed most of the day snow & went
with 2 cows to Colbourns to a new Row that the
Society bought

23 let our own Row out to day got some wood
snow Stormed most of the day

24 the Revd Mr Toplin preached in the schoolhouse this
morning

25 drew in the Seated Blues into the Cellar & fired
a beam for the other potatoes fine day

26 got in the Chilles flourings of snow
snow

27 got in the Seedings stormy in the afternoon
snow with hard frost the ground is very soft
the horses went to the knees in the field

28 drew sand from the pit to bank the haer
with the sloop & one load to the stable
little snow

29 got some wood & other fixings about the
stable cold day Adam got home tonight
from the Red River the went to Nebraska
& slept a week with Isabella all well

30 Ad drew 3 loads of gravel for the
snow stable got wood & killed a sheep
cold with the high winds snow at night
Dove came from Delta with the buggy
