Ground all covered with snow again stormy day snow blusters at intervals all day sunshine at times cold frosty winter weather. Willie took six bags pigchop to 650 lbs to Wilsons brought it up<sup>30c</sup> also bag white dust 80 ct bag shorts at Lark's 100 also paid for chop got on 17<sup>th</sup> 35 paid M<sup>r</sup> Dennott for mending harness traps on 10<sup>th</sup> 20 ds. I cut wood etc In P.M. we went up to J Wilsons and brought down cattle that we put in to pasture on June 6<sup>th</sup> then we brought in two loads turnips.

Thursday

Frosty day, sunny, snow mostly melted today. We got in 2 loads trimmed turnips and two loads hauled ones put on another load trimmed ones and broke tongue of waggon left it in field.

Friday

Snowing and raining in A.M. cloudy all day. Willie went down in cart got lines mended at M<sup>r</sup> Dennotts 40 ds bolts at Mennis to mend tongue 12 ds washers 3. In P.M. I trimmed turnips Willie took one load in chains and all then the load I pulled. In A.M. we mended tongue and brought over the load we left last night.

Fine day. We pulled turnips in A.M. and in P.M. W. Gibson & J. Fernald up we got in 4 or 5 loads and left nearly a load on high waggon in field.
