Fine sunny warm passing clouds.
 Cloudy in morning. ~~rain last night~~
 Redmond Richardson up P.M. hoing and
 helping with hay. Willie & I Raked the
 rows of rakings in No 7 A.M. and I paris
 greened potatoes in new orchard. P.M. we
 took in load rakings from No 7 to other barn
 and 2 loads from No 1 to this barn Willie & I
 it. We cut rest of No 1 after tea.

Cloudy morning gradually cleared off
 sunny but looked like rain P.M. exceedingly
 warm R.A. up all day hoing corn and
 helping with hay. We finished No 7 A.M.
 took load rakings to other barn then load
 over here composed of rakings and the pond
