**Surgical Hints.**

In cases of severe injury demanding amputation it is often advisable to defer operation for twelve to twenty-four hours, until the patient is in a better condition for the anesthesia. To operate immediately on patients addicted to alcohol and with full stomachs, greatly increases the risks of pneumonia, nephritis, or embolism after etherization.—*Int. Journ. of Surg.*
