this evening there is a new Store kept

W. fine rain last night clear today
the woods are fine & green
12 I & J helped scrub Meeting house B &
A plowed back garden A.M. boys drew
dung P.M. W. fine warm clear
we cut scrubby trees out of Burying
ground at Meeting house & staked it
off the old stakes were rotted off
13 boys drew dung I & Nancy & little
ones went to M. N. W. fine & clear
14 boys finished drawing dung
W. fine clear
15 boys drew dung on feed Corn
ground. Strip in wheat field
behind barn. B plowed & fixed it
