E Wind Drifting Snowing Raining Foggy Stormy  
using my Razors 24<sup>th</sup> W Wind Pulling out  
manure Seander for mail got Papers from Dan  
got a Letter from Daisy Bulton with a Photograph  
of James Burt the Boy and Daisy

Wm Cameron Island 25<sup>th</sup> March 1899  
Lucky Day a very Fine Day Seander went to  
Lancaster with Seall took one of the Pans to get  
fixed Bought shoes Pork Licquorice & good  
Crossing on the Ice so they say Lots of Snow  
Bought Shingles 26<sup>th</sup> Fine John H Camerons  
Birth Day 1876 John Dan Spunk Randolph and his  
Wife heard to Day Seander <sup>palm Sunday</sup> went home with them  
took the Horse and Cutter Freezing at night 27<sup>th</sup>  
Fine Day Putting out manure some on Pot to  
ground Wrote a Letter to John Cameron Junction City  
Kansas and 2 Papers a Paper to Miss Daisy Bulton  
Maxville got a Photograph of 7 of them an 2 nice  
Looking Dogs from Blomarch in Alaska  
Skagway an all good Looking Boys they are  
Seander went up with Eddy Kenshaw with 2 Bags  
of Oats 28<sup>th</sup> Fine Soft put out some Manure  
Drew some Stones Drew the Cow to the Lower Point  
Some of the Rousseaus came to Fish Perch  
in the Back Bay got about 20 Seander with them  
Unfortunate Day one of the Sheep a Lamb  
Rained to night scorched or burnt a Rat then  
Let him go to frighten the Rest
