1 Monday 7<sup>mond</sup>  
 Mostly cloudy very heavy rain in AM about noon.  
 Dominion Day, 7<sup>th</sup> after up all day Willie  
 drove mother up at noon and both down in  
 evening. I thinned some turnips Willie  
 cultivated rape land No. 1 4 rows Dan one of them  
 An Irish man was in looking at Nellie  
 he wanted to buy a horse for November. We got  
 mustard pulled out of barley No. 1. We took  
 Kate and Mand down to Fred Armstrong in  
 P.M. let him see Mand's foot he said it  
 had not ringbone. Mary Mitch got 1/2 doz eggs 8  
 I went up to Allans at night paid him 1.00 more

 Cool day cloudy. I thinned turnips all  
 day 8 or so rows Willie thinned in AM  
 and in P.M. harrowed rape land and plowed  
 headlands No. 1. Sold Mitch 1/2 doz eggs 8cts

3 Wednesday  
 Warmer to-day sunny. Mr Bunting over all  
 day hoeing turnips and Mr Lane over in P.M.  
 I hoed in AM plowed green rape land No. 2  
 in P.M. Willie drilled rape land No. 1 AM  
 suffled potatoes and some of corn in P.M.  
 sold Mrs Schanis pigeon 5cts Lane eggs 25-

4 Thursday  
 Fine sunny day warm. Willie down town in evening got meat  
 Mills 45- took to Humphrey butter 48 rape seed 30 rape 15- Bella got week 25- spider  
 Mr Lane being all day. Willie suffled rape No. 1. We plowed No. 2 rape land  
 and suffled some on eggs. We dipped lambs in P.M. with gearseum.  
 Mother up to-day helping with washing etc. over mother got at Nichols on trial.  
 Willie down town at night. got butter morning Mrs Knox 102
