2 Fine warm day sugar \$1.00

3 Very warm Got thank beef 15

4 Hot Hot

5 I washed looks like rain

6 Turned cold to 1 pan bread

7 Rained

8 Woman's meeting at G. L.'s my offering 50cts

9 Got 12 chairs of Nelson's and 1 table 10, bread 25

10 Games today, we went every one, 25 to Adon
Bird gave me 25, I got 2 pans of bread at Dunlop's tick. Got 8 lbs oatmeal 1/2 lb tea at Willis's tick. Hatty is here went to Games

11 Sunday. There was a shower this morning and it turned very cold afterwards

12 Fine bright day, Jimmie went to Alexandria, Pa & Ran. went in afternoon to burn weeds in ditch on thirty acres

13 Jimmie did not get home until this morning, he was at the concert

14 Pa got 41 dollars from Mrs Russell, he paid our acc. at G. L.'s, 3.20, paid Dunlop 50 3.70
Got 2 pans bread this week 50 50

15 I went to the Gore and spent a very pleasant day. got 1 bag of the flour paid the freight of the 6 bags 35cts 35

16 Our Fast day, preparatory to the sacrament. Mr. Mathison Martintown preacher

17 Gordon Smith preacher got 1 lb tea at
