morning Reuben fired some Shots Reuben
and Leander to Summerstown to night
Fine Day Rained to night 21st Saturday Fine
some Wind Reuben started for home him
and Leander Gordon Shingling Gordon Fernandez
Went to Lancaster took 1 Bunch of Shingles
22nd Sunday Fine Leander came from Cornwall
had a Roll of Tar Paper and Hay seed and a
Book sent to me Life of Sir John McDonald
