Cloudy most day some sunshine in P.M.

 got stuck on sand hill hence made two  
 loads of it and brought it home. We  
 pulled and trimmed turnips.

Sunny in morning and at times through day  
 mostly cloudy with snow flurries. Willie  
 Rutherford rep all day. We pulled and  
 trimmed turnips Willie took load turnips  
 down to Schario in A.M. and a load calls  
 home. In P.M. got 2 more loads calls.  
 I got ride down town at night W.K. buggy changed  
 boots at Russells got package blue 5cts. paid Adam  
 Newman for thrashing \$16.50. Willie got  
 from Schario on aft. of turnips \$25.00.
