Mary & Darrin went back to the woods and picked a nice lot of black berries. Dad went down to tell Landon Ivey about the death of his cow. She died Saturday and had a piece of wire next her head.

Tuesday August 2nd

It rained all the forenoon so we couldnt do anything outside. Dad took some milk down to Auntys and Frank and I sharpened the bindy knives then. Mary & I finished making out the Church quarterly statements and Darrin

addressed envelopes for us. I also berries Elgitha while Dad milked her. she gave her kind but an awful scraping some way yesterday and is very touchy about having it milked. After dinner I drove Mary & Darrin down town. Mary deposited the church money and then went down to sit with Aunty ~~there~~ while Aunty Alice went to a party & Mrs. 1 Buckwells. I drove her up there. I drove down again after tea and got the girls who had tea at Auntys and we went to the picture show.

Wednesday August 3rd

Frank cut the oats in the field north & west of the barnyard to day, they feel like a very light crop. and were down in a good many places. Mary drove Darrin down to catch the one o'clock car and she went up to see Mr. Clarke, she says he looks much better than he did on Sunday. Mary brought Mrs. C. G. & Brown & her two kids home with her. To night Mary & I drove down to land cow out and we brought Darrin home. she had stayed for tea at the Bagley's. Mr. Bagley treated us to ice cream. I got ~~it~~ from the band to night. Carles
