 Blew some in the Morning turned calm Drawing
 the things out of the Sugar Bush Fencing the Beech
 for the Soap a Propeller went down 6th Ascension
 Day Blary Calved the Manitoba went down
 on her first Trip East Wind and Rain a lot
 of Boats went down to Day taking the
 Banking from the West End of the house
 Watching the Decays 7th crossed to Vespers with
 3 3 lb of Sugar Bought 17 yds of Calico at 15 cents
 6 yds of Cotton 10 1 Bot of Household Panacea 25 Par 10
 2 Spools of Thread Paper of needles helped
 Willie Rose to put out the scow on
 Hamiltons Island the York went
 down went into Lancaster I Row
 Boat came up Enter prize went into Salmon
 River got 3 Cornwall Papers in the office
 to Day took Dinner at Hamiltons Duncan
 Chisholm there Buying cattle heard
 John and George Nicholson and John James had a fight
 brought over a cake of Sugar to I Grant and
 one for Peter Grant for the use of his
 pot 8th Fencing the Fences began to Thunder
 started to see old Mrs Hopkins as I think she is not
 alive got there and she is no more Jim and
 Charles Maville came heavy thunder Rain and lightning
 Sunday 9th of Newshaws and Munroe and Mr. M^r Carlyle
 Mr. D. Baker Mr. Smallman Mr. P. Buchanan came the

 Jim and P. Buchanan, Charles Grant went
 to the Manitoba to see Mr Phillips about the
 Certificate Put George Grant across Peter
 stopt all night 10th Y. Munroe came Started
 with the Remains met the Steamer
 Jennie and she Rowed us across the Victoria
 took off the Manitoba the Jennie took some
 Passengers of the Manitoba as she turned and
 went for Montreal got to Summerstown got some
 Summers horses and Duncan Cameron Drove
 the Remains out to the Station so we
 Parted with my old friend had a
 few rounds at Summerstown Peter Buchan
 Pete Grant and Charles and I came back
 to the skins had Dinner and we all parted
 I got the Loan of Sims Boat got a calf
 and a Pig as they were going to kill the calf
 I took it to house 11th Making the soap
 taking the Banking from the Lower End
 of the house dug a little in the garden 12th
 crossed to I Hamiltons wind got up stopt
 at Hamiltons took Dinner Mended the Kettle
 strainer John and I the wind lulled for a little
 started for the store and it raised from the
 South and Blew a Gale I stopt all night at
 Munroes all night Brought 2 cakes of sugar
 to Vespers Bought Knife 20 1/2 lb Tea 35 2 plugs 10
 1 lb Flour 1.50 9 yds of Cotton Bag of Salt 20 Stack 10 Soda 6
 1st High Wind came home Hamilton sent a
 cow to Elizabeth the Manitoba down first Fencing fence
 14th (Rose) Pius the 5th (Birth Day) Raining Ice going
 down Fencing the calves Prudence Henry Pete Reggy
 Rosell here for Archys Pot 10 1/2 lb of sugar for the Pot
 1 lb for a hat 1 cake for Pete 2 2 yds of sugar for
 the Children 15th Raining 16th Raining Snowed
 some Lots of Snow on the Mountains Lots of Ice
 going down not many Boats to Day high Wind Taken
 up at the foot of the Island to Frasers 3 in it
 coming back high Wind going set a hen to hatch 15th
