Remember with her so I left the envelope open until morning. Slept outside as usual by night. Practised $\frac{1}{2}$ hour. Read 'The Black'

February 5 (Thursday) Lively day. Went down for meat in the morning and called at Leitch's to enquire after Mrs. Leitch who is still away. Got 5 lbs of soft coal in 15-day. Went over 15th. Darks to get him 15 shovel way in for leave - the snow is so deep. Did 8 copies letters of administration and 5 probates for Charles. Mr. Luer called to bring some literature to Charles for an address. He is to give in Walkerham on Monday night. Took my work down to the office and while there got three letters to write. Just finished a few minutes after 6. Read 'The Globe' and practised $\frac{3}{4}$ of an hour. Read 'The Black'. Slept out.

February 6 (Friday) Fine day - almost like spring. Wrote a letter for Charles to David Savage in Central America reporting fire. (He was in night store) Read 'The Black'. Mrs. Meuser called and stayed for about an hour. After dinner was overseeing dressing of Bertha Leuke and Margaret.
