25¢ 5 M. Minnie went in
eve was a nice day

11 I got 100 Bran 1.35 cigarettes
10 cts. paid my dues in the
P.O.O. \$1.75 to Mrs. 31-5 gave
Will Bates \$1.12 to pay my
dues for 6 mos. in the camp.
I wrote to Liddle Bros. &
J.L. Webster 4 cts for stamps
was a lovely day Mrs. Mackenzie
was here this eve I ordered
some marble from him

12th I have left this morn
88¢ G. D. Mackenzie called
this after-noon I ordered
seven jobs from him spent
20 cts I borrowed 2 cts.
from him I paid 8 tender
girls for a barrel of apples 2.45
25 cts for meat was a nice day

13th I came out to Mrs.
Limes had dinner sold
\$200 job had tea at R. Mullons
Annie came in with me
