- 3 went to Gossaraque to the apple tree - 17
- 4 drew stones in the field south of the house - 18
- 5 went to Malheur town to an agriculture meeting very high wind & snow - 5000 1/2
- 6 went to the schoolhouse & heard the Revd Mr Smart he had the Commencement - 3000 1/2
- 7 went to Caintown with Elmer & Mr. W. - 19
- 8 worked at the wheat Elmer & young helped me Ad came home with a load of lumber & other things drew in a load of oats that is the best of the year - rain 2
- 9 rain last night & a little today worked at the wheat finished drawing the stones of the field - rain 2
- 10 worked at the wheat fine day - 2
- 11 finished cutting the wheat very poor crop it is green yet this forenoon began to plow north of the ditch - 2
- 12 plowed south of the New house for the orchard next the road - 2
- 13 finished the sowing in the wheat little rain last night - 26 Snow
- 14 the Revd Mr Craford preached in the schoolhouse & the Revd Mr Carroll in the Church in the afternoon fine day - 25 Snow
- 15 began to shingle the house N. Jackson helped me Ad plowed in the forenoon went to help A. Turner at the machine -
- 16 Ad drew stones for Grand Trunk & day went to a dinner of George Donson in the afternoon helped A. Turner at trashing machine -
