Diagnosis of Valvular Cardiac Disease.

To determine whether a murmur is systolic or diastolic when rate is rapid or murmur unusual, make intermittent pressure on radial artery to correspond in time with the murmur; if the finger, pressing synchronously with the murmur, feels the radial pulsations, murmur is systolic; if not, diastolic.—Long.
