Detection of Bile and Blood Pigments in the Urine.

A layer of fine, white sand, several mm. in thickness, is spread upon a plate and a little of the urine poured into it. If the urine contains pigment, the sand will be stained in a characteristic manner, a brown stain indicating the presence of hemoglobin, a greenish stain that of bile pigment. The test is said to be trustworthy as well as convenient.—Lipp; Münch. Med. Woch.
