 Unfortunate Day Fine John H. Day
 came from the Bay traded
 my Big Knife with him
 Went with the Horse a piece
 of the way 25th Raining turned
 off me Bill and George Morris
 here Leander went with Randolph
 Boots to get fixed Lawrence (Suso)
 came home with him one of
 Sam Rankin's Sons passed here
 going to see John Rankin up the
 front who is very low Fernandez
 and Gordon sawing wood (having)
 froze some to night weaning the calf
 Gordon filing 4 saws Blackbirds
 came snowbirds plenty 26th June
 Windy Drifting sawing and splitting
 stove wood water on the ice some
 sap a few for the first
 27th June Wendy Gordon crossed
 to Allerton Donalds sale water
 on the ice all of us 3rd in the
 sugar Bush Leander Tapping
 first churning to day about 11 lbs
 Gordon came bought sugar three
 tobacco 28th Unfortunate Day
 Tapping fixing the Pots in the yard
 put a fire under sawing tough skin
 running well cold wind
 clearing some sticks got 50 lbs

Samuel Cameron Island 29th of March
 Unfortunate Day Tapping some
 Windy cool Run 35 Boiling
 wrote 2 Letters 1 for the Toronto
 news with a dollar in it the
 other the Glen Garvan with a
 dollar in it made 3 gallons
 for the first 30th June Boiling
 2 1/2 gallons to day Gordon crossed
 took the 2 Letters to the Post Office
 got the money for Registering
 and Postage Drawing some
 of the stable sticks to the stable
 drew some stones for the arch for
 the Pots went up to the Head
 of the Island Fished the Wine
 barrel yesterday and last years
 Syrup got a Toronto Daily Star
 31st June Randolph here & Wind
 1st of April All Fools Day
 unfortunate Day Fine June Day
 drawing some of the sticks for stable
 drawing the Pots in the arch some
 fising the Pots not running good
 gathered some sap not running good
 Gordon crossed to work at Dineen's
 2nd Tapping to day Boiling and
 gathering set out the wine
 3 gallons came home
