 James Cameron Island 24<sup>th</sup> March 1895  
 Unfortunate Day Fine John H  
 came from the ship traded  
 my Big Knife with him  
 went with the Horse a Pece  
 of the way 25<sup>th</sup> Rainning turned  
 here Leander went with Randolphs  
 Boots to get fixed Linnea (Sissy)  
 came home with him one of  
 Sam Rankin's Sons Passed here  
 going to see John Rankin up the  
 front who is very Low Fernandez  
 and Gordon sawing wood Thawing  
 froze some to night Weaning the calf  
 Gordon Filing 4 Saws Blackbirds  
 came snowbirds Plenty 26<sup>th</sup> Fine  
 Windy Drifting sawing and splitting  
 stove-wood water on the ice some  
 Tapt a few for the first  
 27<sup>th</sup> Fine Windy Gordon crossed  
 to A. M. Donalds sale water  
 on the ice all of us 3 in the  
 sugar Bush Leander Tapping  
 first churning to Day about 11 lbs  
 Gordon came Bought Sugar Thred  
 Tobacco 28<sup>th</sup> Unfortunate Day  
 Tapping Fixing the Press in the arch  
 put a fire under sawing tough Elm  
 running well cold Wind  
 blowing some sticks got 50 ha

James Cameron Island 29<sup>th</sup> March  
 Unfortunate Day Tapping some  
 Windy cool Run 35 Boiling  
 wrote 2 Letters 1 for the Toronto  
 news with a Dollar in it The  
 other the Glangarrian with a  
 Dollar in it Made 3 Gallons  
 for the first 30<sup>th</sup> Fine Boiling  
 2 1/2 Gallons to day Gordon crossed  
 took the 2 Letters to the P Office  
 got the Money for Registering  
 and Postage Drawing some  
 of the stable sticks to the stable  
 drew some stones for the arch for  
 the Pots went up to the Head  
 of the Island Fixed the Wine  
 Barrel yesterday and last years  
 Syrup got a Toronto Daily Star  
 31<sup>st</sup> Fine Randolphs here & Wind  
 1<sup>st</sup> of April all Fools Day  
 Unfortunate Day Fine Fine Day  
 Drawing some of the sticks for stable  
 fixing the Pots in the arch some  
 gathered some sap not running good  
 Gordon crossed to work at Dineanly  
 2<sup>nd</sup> Tapping to Day Boiling and  
 gathering Set out the Swine  
 3 Gallons came home
