- Thurs 17 I was drawing Stone for foundation of the  
 Maden Building at Lonsdon
- Fri 18 a very windy day
- Sat 19 I was working on the Mill all day } 2 got 18 Bushes  
 of grain ground
- Sun 20 I went out to Frankhill to buy with Mrs Ham  
 a New But Coal Dry
- Mon 21 I drove out to Cranworth near Smith Falls
- Tue 22 I drove all through Burgess to buy  
 a Terrible Wind Storm to 8 1/2 a Big Pin in Augusta
- Wed 23 I was down to Pike Falls and Olivars Ferry  
 Mr N.R. Johnston died at 6 PM
- Thurs 24 I drove through a lot of New Boyre  
 a Snow Storm
- Fri 25 I drove through the Portland District and Back to  
 Mr N.R. Johnston was buried
- Sat 26 I came home from Cranworth to night
- Sun 27 a Nice But Cool Day The Roads are very Muddy  
 The Mare had a colt this morning
- Mon 28 I plowed the garden to day  
 a Nice warm Day
- Tue 29 I got 4 Gall Coal Oil and planted some Potatoes  
 I put out some Manure and filled up the garden  
 with 4 Gall Coal Oil
- Wed 30 a Terrible Heavy Rain Storm Last Night  
 The Month Ends here but the Seed is by wet

The 5<sup>th</sup> Month May: 31 Days 1902

- Thurs 1 I was fixing up fence a very wet but cool day  
 the North Begins to cool
- Fri 2 I was drawing stone all day to the Mill yard  
 Lonsdon
- Sat 3 another very wet day I Dined at day  
 the 10° F Gradual to Church to 2 1/2 to 3 1/2  
 to Methodist Church
- Sun 4 quarterly Meeting to day. Mary and I sang at the Church  
 Show to day
- Mon 5 a Terrible Heavy Rain Storm Last Night very to day
- Tue 6 another very wet day
- Wed 7 I took uncle Andy out to uncle Eddes by Road
