Cool last night not quite so warm to-day sunny. Willie took 10 hops down to chains they weighed 1730 @ 665 - \$115.00 weighing 20 he got harness mended at Mr. Dennis 30 cts brought up balance of 1/2 ton & got Saturday night on fire. In P.M. he brought load sand provisions then hauled buckwheat and rapeland. Mr. Sum over all day being mangles. I scuffed potatoes corn and some turneps. I went to hospital Gordon Party at night expenses 40 cts
