Wed 12 started to rain at Paul & I was out rained on & off all the forenoon the boys all in the other house for dinner they are not doing anything both boys stayed there last night we had another mess of peas for dinner Paul gone to Hestons after the strawberries & I churned & put the last churning on the crock  
Thurs 13 Paul hved the yellow corn in forenoon went to Tom Somersville after dinner Marjorie washed a dirty washing. I made bean & cornmeal & cornmeal pudding for dinner Arthur over on the evening. I pulled a lot of weeds on the  
Friday 14. Colman a birthday he is 12 years old Jennie & the boys in Dell for dinner they had a chicken for dinner. she worked in the other house for dinner. I churned. then went out hved a lot of potatoes & planted some. they drew on the last of their hay Keck came to see if Marjorie would stay with the children when the

Gal 15. went to market - the children have the whooping cough she went tonight. I will want to set up with James Dell. Marjorie got 60 & a 2 gal. jar of wine  
Sat 15. I hved a swarm of bees on the hill red hvy. Jennie & Hattie went to Chippawa took 13.4 at 16 ps lb. cam 2.12. got 6 loaves bread 36 tea 25 - H 7 eq 3 screen door 125 hinges 15 cheese 8. Jennie ironed some of their shings. I cleaned the kitchen packed the crock of butter Marjorie came home early & finished her dress. Paul never came home from Somersville. Arthur started to cut the field opposite the school house  
Sun 16 Marjorie & Jennie went to church. John Oliver in the other house all day. at night we had singing & playing  
Mon 17 Terrible hot - just - dreadful. The Dell died this morning at six. Marjorie took Jennie & the boys down to Chippawa to go home I just got the dikes gathered & carried out. when Ray came stayed for dinner & for tea in the other house a dreadful thunder storm about 8 o'clock lasted an hour never got any cooler Arthur raked a little untill 7 o'clock came home. then Will raked with her & the boys drew on made a stack by the barn  
Tue 18 died on Peter's birthday he is 839 had Missions & west
