Cocoa. no bait there

nice residences along

from here to Melbourne
a few miles. some nice

turned west on Road 24
towards Kissimmee for
about 40 miles we saw
one vacant house. two
or three nigger shanties.
saw a few herds of
cattle. passed about
6 cars on the road
saw a few niggers fishing
in the ditch by the
side of the road (had
fish too) saw a few
hundred cranes, white
ones & grey ones a few
herons. some turkey
buzzards. mile of
swamps. other miles of
palmettos etc. had
about 20 miles of bad
road rough only made
about 10 to 20 miles an
hour on it. Passed through
