

July 1901
25 A & Henry both at Flavin's
Came home at noon & went to help
D Clean out the Cistern. W. not so
warm. Clouded up with East wind
began to rain, slow & steady about
5 P.M. raining yet at bed time

26 A & Henry worked at Flavin's & Chores
D Gousson made his last round this week
W. very fine & cool a fine rain last evening
there was some water in the road this
morning as I went to Cedar Grove

27 Boys drove in last of barley till
noon then there came a fine little
shower then they took about 34 bags
of mixed grain to the store & took
by 5 bags barley to Chop when they came
home they brought in the barley & sacking
till supper a heavy rain after supper
a little distant thunder in the cool

Monday 28 Adeline Mary & Henry started to
go to meeting at Niedemanns rain stopped
them at David's they staid to dinner & supper
I & Mary walked to A B's to dinner
W. very warm this A.M. showers of rain
till about 10 A.M. then showers after
showers from about 2 P.M. till dark
Ada Hane was here to dinner & staid
all night some thunder not very heavy

July 1901 Aug
29 Boys Chores. A worked at Truck
Wheels I & Henry began plowing in pasture
W. foggy A.M. drizzly rain after
dinner very heavy thin evening our dam
is about full.

30 Henry helped Thomas Truck all day
I & A plowed awhile then fixed up the
Wheat shocks till noon then I cut
mixed grain north of Orchard he nearly
finished it A went to Ormeau's barn
raising P.M. W. cloudy warm fine
Breeze

31 I finished mixed grain & cut Oats
west of dam & began opposite Pillsbury
A & Henry shocked & drew in 1 load
of wheat after supper W. fine &
Cooler Mary & Anne went to Markham
P.M.

Aug 1 I finished cutting Oats opposite
Pillsbury & cut most of Knoll Oats A
& Henry drew in 4 loads wheat A.M.
Henry helped Flavin's Truck P.M.
A shocked Oats P.M. I & he drew
in a load of wheat after supper
W. very fine a cool wind
