P M. W. heavy rain this morning
fire truly cool this evening

July 1 B began building foundation wall
for shed at Jo H attended him I scuffled
corn A drew home some wood A M

July 1892
They had P M B. C. brought P M
Joseph Wisner & wife here to dinner
I & Nancy went with them to P M
Peters then to M Barkers & to
Dac Peters they were not at home
then we went to Mamasse Fret's
to supper & left them there
W. fire A M heavy shower 6 P M
2 B finished wall & tended him
H worked for B. D. W. fire A M
cloudy P M heavy steady rain this
evening raining yet bed time

July 3 I & Nancy went to Meeting at
Altona remarks by B. C. sermon on
at C 1st Epist. St Peter by Joseph Wisner
went to M. No. after service W. rain
last night slacked a little this morning
then rained all day. didn't get any wet
4 H. B. & A went fishing to mouth of
Rouge. got 5. I & B drew 2 log. P M
W. fire & clear creek not very high
5 Boys drew 5 logs & scuffled corn &
potatoes. W. fire & clear they turned
the clover that was cut on Thursday
W. fire I & Henry went fishing with
Hork & him to B. No. flats caught about
50 Chubs. mostly small ones
