

19 Drove in rakes & plow at 10 AM. W scuffled turnip drills (there are scarcely any turnips) P.M. then he went to show in Markham & after supper. I & little boys took first to Cedar Grove Mills P.M. W. fine

20 I & Nang went to M. Neighswands & Simon Hoovers I took part of scaper to Mongolia W. fine clear

Sunday 21 I & Nance staid with my Mother girls went to Meeting at Hebron. W. fine shower this morning another heavy one P.M. not many at the meeting Old David Hoovers & Isaac Peason were here P.M. Isaac is doing the amiable! to Janet while I am writing. my Mother is not so well today a she was a few days ago she was able to walk to B.C.'s

22 I went to Markham A.M. W helped B.C. get out a stick of timber. W drilled over about an acre of turnips P.M. I & I sowed them white globe seed. W. fine. Clear

23 Boys cut round round upper wheat field & I helped B.C. get scaper ready A.M. I raked off for B.C. cutting his barley & W began crossing new fallow W. fine a little rain P.M.

24 I helped B.C. finish cut barley with scaper W. clear

25 Cut 8 rounds wheat in N.W. field this morning then I went to raising B.C.'s barn at Dykes boys bound wheat & cut a round round field at end of lane. W. pretty warm, looks like rain tonight

26 Cut wheat. a little rain A.M. clear P.M.

27 Finished N.W. field till 4 O'clock then drove Stebbins hay 2 loads after supper. W. fine. Clear

Sunday 28 at home all day Ruthamah & Benjamin Delley were here W. fine. Clear

29 Cut wheat in P.C. woods W. Cradled in rough part till about 11 O'clock when it began to rain drizzly & cloudy all day heavy shower about supper time I & Nance went to Cedar Grove after supper I shot a qt of the woodchuck this evening

30 Finished cutting wheat didnt get it all bound W. clear

31 Finished binding & shocking wheat A.M. I & W cut barley back of garden. Dave helped Flawins bind wheat P.M. W. fine. Cool. Clear

August 1 I & W went ^{up} to the field east of Am 5 and finished at about 2 past 2 O'clock then drove in 2 loads of Treadwell wheat began to rain about 6 O'clock

2 I went to Markham A.M. Chored P.M. W. warm clear A.M. Showy P.M.

3 Drove 2 loads Edging A.M. W finished plowing new fallow & drew out some wood he reckoned P.M. I & little John went for my stuffed Bittern & got a barrel of salt at Bay W. fine warm. Clear

Sunday 4 He & my Mother went to A.B.'s they were out at home. then we went to J.D.'s P.M. W. fine clear

5 Finished drawing in N.W. wheat field 12 good loads

6 Drove in double wheat in field below townline till supper then I went to J.B.'s & boys drew in 3 loads barley W. very warm clear

7 drew in 4 loads barley till 11 O'clock when a shower came up then I & Nance & little boys went to A.B.'s & I went to Cherry wood. came back after supper boys brought 1 load & I helped to bring 2 more till night

8 Drove 1 load of barley out of lower field & 9 out of upper. Simon Hoovers were here at supper W. fine very warm

This is Election day in South Ontario's Concern of P. White is endeavoring to run out Tony Giles

9 Drove 3 small loads barley out of upper field & W took waggon to shop to get lines set A.M. began putting sod peas with horse rake. works well. W. fine warm very sorry to hear that Tony Giles is elected

10 Finished pulling peas till about 3 P.M. cut round round spring wheat till supper W. brought waggon home after supper. W. warm

Saturday 11 at home. W. warm. a little cloudy

12 Cut spring wheat A.M. J.B. helped. W. helped I drove thrash with team W. cloudy A.M. fine shower about 1 O'clock P.M. I & Nance went to Whitewall P.M.

13 I & J.B. began cut oats in field behind side house A.M. bound spring wheat P.M. W. pretty warm. cloudy W. helped I took truck A.M. I & C.B. P.M.
