Henry plowed and while there cut a road  
around our feed Corn till I came  
home he finished cutting Corn at N. B.  
I cut a while at Johnny Reesor's then  
cut over till noon the part that we  
intend for fall feed then he cut I do  
M. Barkley till night A & Henry drove  
along the fence P.M. W. warm  
only East wind a slight shower P.M.  
clear after dark
