Far took Solomon and took me to the Fair just as I got in on the door the rain began to fall. And there were heavy showers all afternoon. I came home about 4.30 and saw nothing of the exhibits. The building was so crowded. At I gave 25. for C. G. H 25

Sent \$2.00 for Home Mission 25 for Childrens Sunday 2.25
We put a fire in the furnace tonight
- 30 Hard frost last night - all my flowers just the first frost since spring. I bid from a hawkie a wire machine for cleaning lamp chimneys, taking corks out of bottles
It grabs a rag and you can clean the stove, wash bottles, gem jars, wash dishes in fact I will not do any thing. cost 75 15
The sun is out, The corn is wilted, so is the tomato and beans, late buckwheat is doomed
Gave 4 brick to Sawdell's chimney
