Four Common Types of Heart Disease—No. 4.

4. Nephritic heart-disease.

These cases have features in common with the preceding group. They are characterized by urinary symptoms, as nocturia, albuminuria, etc.; high blood-pressure without demonstrable peripheral arteriosclerosis; deficiency in renal function as shown by the phthalein test; retinitis; and frequently uremic phenomena.—Cabot; J. A. M. A.
