The Mastoid in Otitis Media.

It is the consensus of opinion to-day that all cases of acute middle ear suppuration are complicated by an inflammation of the mastoid cells. In favorable cases the mucous membrane alone is involved and absorption of the pus from the mastoid cavity slowly takes place before or after the middle ear has healed; at other times an osteitis of the mastoid develops, and healing, if it does take place, occurs very slowly. It may be questionable if a true osteitis of the mastoid cells ever heals completely without operative intervention.—*Wm. Mithoefer; Lancet-Clinic.*
