Retention of the Urine.

In post-operative or other simple retention of urine, even if such devices as enemata, hot-water bag over the bladder, the administration of spiritus etheris nitrosi, dipping the hands in hot water, and producing the sound of running water, fail to provoke micturition, catheterization may often be obviated in the female by the simple trick of placing the patient on a well-warmed bed-pan in which has been poured a little spirits of turpentine.—*American Journ. of Surg.*
