Mr James Cameron Island Easter Sunday
 Cloudy this morning the sun dont Dance a
 Sign of a very hard year the Sheep laid
 on the other Lamb and killed it Lashy Crested
 to Tom Cotters a fine Day 2 Buildings came down
 with the high Water on the night of the 19th The
 Hogansburgh Mill & Mannings Storehouse 100 tons
 to Mr Morris Lashy Livinia and me the water
 very high 22nd took home her chest called at
 Naville found a squaw stick on the way coming
 Found a Canoe Lashy Chipping Begs to Ram
 Raining at night East Wind 23rd The water Log
 Moved with the Wind Went around the Island
 firing the N. Big canoe Found a nest under the
 Barn let out the Sheep & Lambs
 24th St Georges Dry Hellum England
 St 2. Traps for the Fox Snowing Blowing
 freezing 24th Helping Lashy to split
 his Maple Trees cold Day but fine
 25th Saw a young Alek here for the Boards
 Lashy went to Hunt finding the cart for the
 Draw Wood getting a Rat or 2 now & again
 Circle around the Sun West Wind Sap rising at
 Angus came Immanuel came 26th Fishing 28th
 got 14 or 15 of them Livinia sick Shot 2 ducks got
 1 27th Windy something hurtled the Lamb Tom Cotters
 here Bought 1/49 Tea 1/3 Pa. & Japan Tea wanting
 Powder Tom got 2 Rats 28th Weather here Wind
 high 29th Went to Mr Morris's shop tall
 Bought a Grindel Street 1 pair of Boots
 30th Came with Cow & calf in the
 31st Traps sold the canoe Laura and

 Boat 3rd Went to a Summers Bought Syrup
 1/2 Gal 1/5 Whisky 2/6 Pitcher 1/6 pins 1/6 oak Barrel 1/10
 needles 1/2 Shot 1/6 fork 16 lb 4/4 Butter 1/4
 Andrew Bakers store closed up Bonquet began
 to Run Firing Hamiltons Bridge heard a Summer
 Being seized & David Sunday 4th High Wind
 no one here Boats going in a lundance Salaberry
 on to Salmon River St Lawrence down Rafts
 going down ground with snow on the Island yet seen
 a Weasel all Red 6th Francis here with 3 hens
 1 Kuster allowed him 5/ for them part
 pay of the Canoe gave him some oil Laura &
 Livinia went across took the canoe & sold to
 Mr Morris for a Lamb in the Fall
 setting fires to the grass Firing ashes in
 the Bags took the Wood out of the cellar
 all alone Took up my Traps hurted my eye
 7th Snowing Blowing & Raining Salaberry went
 up 8th began to Plough a Summers here &
 Long John gave them 2 pieces of Timber 24
 Lenght Hemlock 32 Planted Potatoes before the
 door Bill Liss & Livinia came 9th setting fires
 Found a Ducks nest 5 eggs on the Pitt Point
 10th Ploughed the garden setting fire
 to bone the fence the 11th
