Tuesday

Fine day mostly sunny looked like rain at times. warm. E.B. M. Campbell.

Barbara and horse here all day, Mr Cook here A.M helping with silos. We finished filling silos - day heaped up into roof also several loads corn piled along fence etc. Willie got steak ^{shorts} 40cts gasoline Chapman's 40 paid 45cts balance from yesterday. He got at James yesterday 5 batteries \$1.25.
