at 7. L. I paid him in full \$5.50. P.M. Willie harnessed Nolo
I cleaned pig pen shut up small pigs etc. Annie Mearns here P.M.

rest of animals paid for some time ago plus refund 5 cts. We paid E. Blackwell \$2.00
