dreadful hot-day we are almost frost-  
ated with the heat thunders in the distance  
Mon 19 heat something terrible & thundering  
one time I thought we were going to get it &  
got the horses in but it passed over Marjorie  
washed a big washing then went at her linen  
waist to fix it over I churned & planted a  
row & a half of potatoes after Arthur & Paul  
furrowed out - then they cultivated the potatoes  
made a good job on them the ground was  
turning green. Hattie washing all day. Paul  
put on some potatoes. Will went to Clefton  
with a load of oaks. Will Grey died today  
Tue 20 Arthur & Will ploughing the lane Hattie  
washing again. Little chicks coming out of  
the barn. Marjorie working at her waist got  
my hand healed nearly over bad over two weeks  
Wed 21. Paul weeding & I helped him he got  
a mass of strawberries enough for two meals  
when he was guarding the cows Marjorie was going  
over the river until she heard of Berry he being  
on Friday sprinkled rain in forenoon afternoon the  
funeral of Wella Grey. Hattie went on to Chippawa

Thurs 22 Marjorie went to Chippawa had 9 lbs 25  
butter @ 14 & 2 doz eggs @ 20. got 3 gals of permit  
@ 12 1/2 lbs per gal got 1 1/4 lbs 1 lb cheese 12 lbs lemons 2 bars bread  
peppermints that 18th Paul working for Will Henry  
Friday 23 real cool with wind Hattie & I  
went to pick berries at Hewsons made the sum  
of 29th Marjorie baked a big baking of bread  
Paul at Hills got - today. I am so tired I  
could hardly walk home I feel pounded  
all over I never felt worse on my life Marjorie  
back is bad but Hattie is played out her  
lots gone to Niagara to see the Soldiers.  
Sat. 24 I feel pounded from head to foot & such  
a pain on my back & chest I could hardly churn  
I cleared up the back wood house & that all I could  
do Hattie & her mother went to Chippawa Arthur cut the  
roadside grass then went & cut on their hill  
Marjorie ironed a lot of starched things on the week  
& finished ~~Wella~~ ~~Wella~~ old Pottery always then  
swarmed their bees. Reeb called to see if he  
could get a swarm of bees  
Sun 25. quiet day no one here Will & Hattie went  
to see James Dell Clara Miss Colman then for school  
Mon 26. I churned & worked & pa - real sore  
churning. Paul guarded the cows & got strawberries  
Marjorie & Hattie went to pick berries at  
Hewsons good picking she made 5 lbs quite  
cool. I feel so mean with my cold
