Sat Nov 30<sup>th</sup> cloudy fore part of the day and moderate. I went down to the old place and got Dick to bring me a load of wood

Sun Dec 1<sup>st</sup> clear and pleasant  
Mr Burton preached to day

Mon Dec 2<sup>nd</sup> cloudy and cool. I Splitt Stove wood and in the Shop in the fore noon after noon dug around the quince trees and Shortend tops of peach trees

Tue Dec 3<sup>rd</sup> cloudy and cold I was helping dig Walters cistern

Wed Dec 4<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cold. about an inch and a half of Snow fell last night not doing anything to day

Thu Dec 5<sup>th</sup> clear and cool

Fri Dec 6<sup>th</sup> clear part of the day and cold I went down with Dick to Dresden for some panel for Shirts & drawers

Sat Dec 7<sup>th</sup> cloudy and soft. Aunt Mary and Mead was here. not doing much myself

Sun Dec 8<sup>th</sup> rain most of the day. Aunt Mary Ann Mead was here last night and most of to day went to geremiah Tiffin's this afternoon

Mon Dec 9<sup>th</sup> cloudy and moderate. after noon Snow

Tue Dec 10<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool. about 3 inches of Snow fell last night and to day. was in the house most of the day

Wed Dec 11<sup>th</sup> cloudy and soft. the Snow melting and falling of the rice. not doing much myself

Thu Dec 12<sup>th</sup> cloudy and soft. in the fore noon went over to William Hawgood's to see his chickens. after noon went down home.

Fri Dec 13<sup>th</sup> cloudy rain most of the fore noon the about gone was not away from the house

Sat Dec 14<sup>th</sup> snow all day rain most of the night not doing much to day.

Sun Dec 15<sup>th</sup> clear and cold the thermometer down to 5 deg above zero

Mon Dec 16<sup>th</sup> clear and cold the thermometer at zero this morning not doing much myself. Bilton was here visiting this after noon. Dick drew me a load of wood
