

Croton May 1888

Fri May 18<sup>18</sup> cloudy and cool, misting rain part of the day, we were drawing out manure

Sat May 19<sup>19</sup> cloudy and quite cool, we were drawing out manure in the fore noon, I went over to Johns this after noon for lumber and potatoes, the rest of the time spreading manure

Sun May 20<sup>20</sup> clear and pleasant a hard frost last night.

Mon May 21<sup>21</sup> clear and pleasant, Walter finished plowing the old sheep paddock North East of the barns, I was spreading manure.

Tue May 22<sup>22</sup> clear and pleasant, I was putting in some lights in the windows and cutting potatoes in the fore noon, after noon went to Shamesville for potatoes for seed, Walter harrowed and marked the little field by the barn in the fore noon after noon planted part of it to corn.

Croton May 1888

Wed May 23<sup>23</sup> clear and warm, we were sowing carrots and planting potatoes and drilling in a little corn.

Thu May 24<sup>24</sup> clear and hot, Walter plowed the young Orchard ground, I was cutting potatoes, was up to the Church to hear the funeral Sermon of the late Mrs Weldon

Fri May 25<sup>25</sup> cloudy a little rain this evening we were planting potatoes and sowing mangolds in the young orchard.

Sat May 26<sup>26</sup> light clouds and hot, Walter was plowing the little piece North of the ditch which finishes his Spring plowing for this season, <sup>I was</sup> working in the young Orchard, most of the day.

Sun May 27<sup>27</sup> cloudy and warm a little rain

Mon May 28<sup>28</sup> cloudy some light showers, we were planting corn and drilling a few mangolds, finished all our seeding but a few turnips
