The day was very disagreeable with rain, snow and wind, but he said he was comfortable in the Sudan.

The roads were bad but not sticky.

Tuesday March 21, 1922

Kent went on the car and got the mail and then took the mail all but the Lowline; I did the Lowline with Charlie's Gipsy.
