

Monday 13 M N's & C B's ^{Sept} were here at supper W
14 I went to Uncle Josephus Pears to get a tooth
extracted this morning Boiled sauce to day Joe
Plowed in Pea ground back of garden with Iron
Plow. Can make out to a pinch W. warm
15 I went to Markham to get Cylinder, it was not
done. Joe threshed Peas I helped a little P.M. W
warm a few drops rain A.M. fine shower P.M.
16 I went to Markham & got Cylinder & Mr. Dewit
to fix it into the Machine. took him home again
P.M. Joe Plowed. W. Clear Cool
17 I didn't do much Joe threshed Peas. W
fine drizzly rain nearly all day, pretty heavy
18 Joe Plowed in Pea ground I Chorded & plowed
some in little Out field. W. fine Clear. a fine rain
last night, it soaked in 3 or 4 inches
19 Both Plowed. W. fine Clear
Sunday 20 at home. B's were here. W. Cool. Clear
heavy rain last night. looks like spring again
21 I Plowed Joe helped B's Co. log. W. fine Clear
22 Both Plowed I finished Out stubble below house
23 Joe went to Toronto to Exhibition I drew a load
of my Clear Lumber to Markham Station
B's I sold it @ \$24.00 per M. W. fine Clear
24 I drew 1 load Lumber & Joe drew 2 loads
I went to Cherrywood P.M. W. fine Clear
25 I & Joe drew last 2 loads Lumber A.M. Joe plowed
I went to Sawmill for Out Chop P.M. W. warm Clear
26 I & Nancy went to Whitvale this Morning there
I helped Joe finish plowing Pea ground back of
garden & we began in spring wheat stubble behind
barn W. fine warm Clear I shot 3 black squirrels
at C B's Corn at noon
Sunday 27 I Nancy My Mother & little boys went
to A B's. W. Cloudy A.M. rain nearly all P.M. rain
This is my 38th Birth day
28 Joe helped I Hall threshed I chored Plowed a little P.M.
W. rain & drizzly I took a horse to B's N. this morning

29 Joe Plowed in ^{Sept} 1874 Spring wheat stubble I went to
Belgard this morning Plowed a few rounds A.M. then I went
to B.D. P.M. Picked a few apples P.M. W. Clear A.M. Cloudy
30 Both Plowed. W. pretty Cold. Strong N West wind
Oct 1 I Plowed. Joe took some boards to Markham
to cover our lumber pile. The buyer will not take
it away until about 2 weeks. then he drew
straw from Halls for Flawing P.M. W. Cloudy
began to rain heavy at dark. raining yet
2 Joe went to Markham Fair I finished plowing
Spring wheat stubble behind barn & drew a
load Pea straw for Flawing A.M. Chorded P.M.
3 Joe began plowing in full wheat stubble
I went to Rosegrove for a landside for Patterson
Plow A.M. it did not fit. went for another
P.M. it was right. Then I Plowed a little. W
Sunday 4 Nancy & girls went to meeting at Cedar Grove
I staid with My Mother I D were here W. Cool Clear
5 Both Plowed A.M. Picked apples P.M.
W. fine Clear. began to rain slowly. tonight
6 Joe threshed Peas & I Chorded A.M. I & Nancy went
to Markham & a few minutes to J B Pears. his
wife is sick with Bilious & Gastric fever several
of the family & some of their neighbours had it
W. rain nearly all A.M. a little wet P.M.
7 I & Joe helped thresh at B's Co. W. Cloudy
8 I & Joe helped finish thresh at B's Co. A.M. Joe
Plowed P.M. & I went squirrel shooting awhile
with Peter & Jesse Hoover. I shot 2 & Peter shot 1
9 I & Joe Plowed. W. Clear. rain ^{W. Cloudy rain} last night
10 Both Plowed until about 2 past 10 when it began to rain
Joe threshed Peas P.M. & I went to Flawing & the Cedar Grove
Sunday 11. I & Children went to meeting at Markham
Nancy staid with my Mother remarks by B.D Hoover
sermon on St Mat's by Rev H Baskin C B's
were here P.M. W. Cool. Cloudy
12 Plowed A.M. killed a heifer P.M. C B's man
helped me. W. Cloudy. Cold North wind
