Willie dropped some a M.

Tuesday

Ground frozen this morning cold morning fine sunny day. We cut elm tree log on N.D. Orchard once through them we finished seeding the No 3 oats with a ds drill we continued the Deans fertilizer over to next furrow and a little beyond then a mixture of the two to wheat except next wheel we sowed no fertilizer. Willie took the drill down to A.G. after dinner and brought up the waggon. We finished no 1 to-day I sowed rest of land at N E side of No 1 finishing next fence with ~~1/2~~ 1/2 suds width of No 3 oats. I started cultivating in No 7 other side O. barn. Aunt Aggie down home.
