Stormy day snowing at times not very frosty. We hauled back 2 loads manure to S.L. field and Willie and Mary went down town in sleigh brought up chop 55 shoes mended 10 Mary got at Steels print 10 Powell's medicine at Phillips 30 drawers at Woods in A.P. 1.00 Bible Society 2.00
