Bella and Mary down at Aunties in P.M. for tea Jennie Sandham and baby there bought of Mrs Quance 6 lbs butter 85

Fine sunny day Willie drove down in buggy helped William Mc Kee take steer and heifer we bought from him over to home field above pump. then he got at Mennies on eye 10 lbs bluestone and at line kin 5 lbs lime to make Bordeaux mixture we then plowed clay along ditch running A & and hauled 3 or 4 loads clay down to smock part. In P.M. Jim and Doug here hoeing mangolds I scuffled some sold to Jackson in evening 2 gal cream
