\$10 to weedy

Wednesday 19th fine
we plowed all day J Webster
J. W. Cameron came at noon & Martin
left I paid him \$4.16 416

Thursday 20th fine
I got meat & sent \$11 to
Quebec. for Cattle and
65¢ for Telegrams 1000
