SATURDAY 28

(271-94)

It was a cold cloudy day The wind was in the east I helped Archie draw in his barley it began to rain about 4 o'clock Howard and Katie came back 29 It rained all day Howard and Katie went to Winchester 1918 It was kind of dull and showery I drew my mare Fred & boy dug some potatoes & pulled a few of Fred's beans I drew in our beans The children went over to the church to practice for rally
