- Mar 25th Burned brush in afternoon clearing up around the house and
 - 27 - Sold Freddie (a year old colt) to Watson McPherson for \$140.00 ^(arched)
 - 28 - Finished cleaning seed grain and sweet clover out of oats (3 bags)
 - 29 - A fine day, stretched fence from the creek to the road gate.
 - 30 - Took a load of 6 pigs to Brantford 1210 lbs at less than 6 mos old
 a cold east wind all day turning to rain and an ice storm at
 - 31 - Woke up last night with the La Grippe and a very sore ^(right)
 finger which proved to be blood poison.
 The trees were all loaded down with ice again which
 proved as bad and worse in some places on account of the
 wind, which broke off large telephone poles by the 2 mile - place
- Apr 1st Turned out to be a very nice day after March's closing storm
 - 3rd Tom drew up the manure for the hot-bed & we made it up.
 Pollyanna had a black & white heifer calf. Trimm'd grapes.
 - 5th Jim Duncan of Brantford dropped in for dinner and a little visit
 - 6 - Sowed Tomatoes, Lettuce & Aster seed in the hot-bed.
 - 7 - Drew in remainder of straw stack. Mr & Mrs Lee came over for dinner
 - 8 - Sowed Sweet clover on wheat ground & seeded 4 acres at the
 bush, with Sweet clover Red C. & Alsike and timothy about 10 lbs per
 - 10 - A very warm spring day, took the car out for the first time
 going to town and to Will Millers for tea.
 - 11 - A splendid rain last night and nearly all forenoon took
 3 cattle to the Glen to C. E. Meggs.
 - 13 - Finished sawing ^{up} wood in the forenoon and sawed
 Johnsons in the afternoon.
