Treatment of Ingrowing Toenail.

Lehmann recommends a simple procedure for the treatment of this condition, consisting in the application to the ingrowing edge of the nail, as well as to the inflamed soft tissues, of a dilute solution of ferric chloride. A small pledget of absorbent cotton, mounted on a stick of wood, is used, and care taken to insert it as deeply as possible. The ferric chloride should be allowed to act some time, though it is not necessary that a permanent tampon of it be left. No pain is caused. An application is made daily.—Tribune Medicale.
