I plowed all day No 6 Willie took 450 lbs horse chop down in a M^W 124 at got birds which M: D. 50 osler cowboys 10 meat grain gave Father two cheques one each a Duff & Trades Bank for 900.00 & 200.00 respectively to go on mortgage on the Smellies farm. Mary down P.M. got at Russells cents 13cts pd and goods \$2.65 a/c at Armstrongs. What farms 50 pd (Willie also got three bran & shorts 400 a/c) at Phillips note paper 10 stamps & at Steals dry goods \$2.25. Mr Bass milk 5. Willie rebelled to drive at night. Willie suffered potatoes in P.M. with Mand.
