 Smellies farm. May down P.M. got at Russell's comb
 13 cts pd and goods \$2.65 n.c. of Armstrong What
 farms 50 pd (Willie also got three brace shorts 60 n.c.)
 at Phillips' note paper 10 stamps & at Stacks by goods
 \$2.25. Mr Bass milks 5-. Willie wheeled to town at night.
 Willie snuffed potatoes in P.M. with Mand.
