The Care of Surgical Patients—No. 14.

Postoperative Hemorrhage.—As a rule, this condition is readily recognized but, if any doubt exists, one should make absolutely certain. Deeply jaundiced cases are more treacherous in this regard, the slow coagulation-time combined with the peculiar changes in the vessels themselves, making a secondary oozing very likely. In a few cases, we have observed undoubted benefit follow transfusion and in many cases questionable benefit from the use of horse serum.—*Balfour; Mayo Clinic. Med. Record.*
