Nephritis, Acute.

Saline proctoclysis advised in acute nephritis in children. Tends to relieve edema and subjective symptoms and improve condition of urine. Normal salt solution, kept at about 110° F. by hot-water bottles surrounding graduated container, passed into rectum through soft-rubber catheter, which is inserted about 6 to 8 inches after a cleansing enema. Procedure also useful in acute infectious diseases and toxemic diseases, as well as before and after ether anesthesia.—Lowenburg.
